PANEL's objectives

The PANEL project wants to address the needs of both teachers and learners, and to turn difficulties into opportunities for social development. The project therefore aims to:

- 1. provide teachers with suggestions and IT tools to overcome difficulties in e-learning environment;
- 2. improve training methodologies in e-learning environment in the areas of: foreign language learning, art workshops, physical and mental well-being, ICT;
- 3. motivate low-skilled adults in the IT field to be active in e-learning environments.

PANEL's project's results

PANEL foresees the development of three main results:

- Evaluation report of teacher and learner questionnaires and good practices concerning E-learning courses: Under the lead of University of Malaga, the report is aiming to assess the needs of trainers and low-skilled users in the IT field and to be able to prepare effective E-learning training courses using innovative methodologies.
- Preparation of pilot programmes: Under the lead of KAINOTOMIA, partners will prepare 4 pilot programmes about foreign languages, psychological and physical well-being, ICT and artistic laboratories.
- Realisation of guidelines for trainers: Under the lead of the coordinator, partners' will develop guidelines to support trainers in the implementation of the pilot programme.
