There are several options for accessing the modules: full download of the guide, download of modules, while each module has buttons for downloading both the chapter and the respective infographic.



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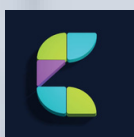
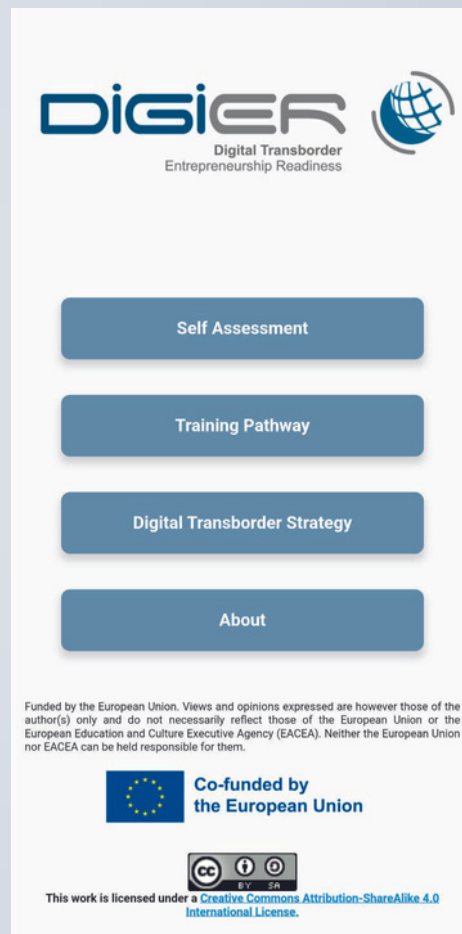
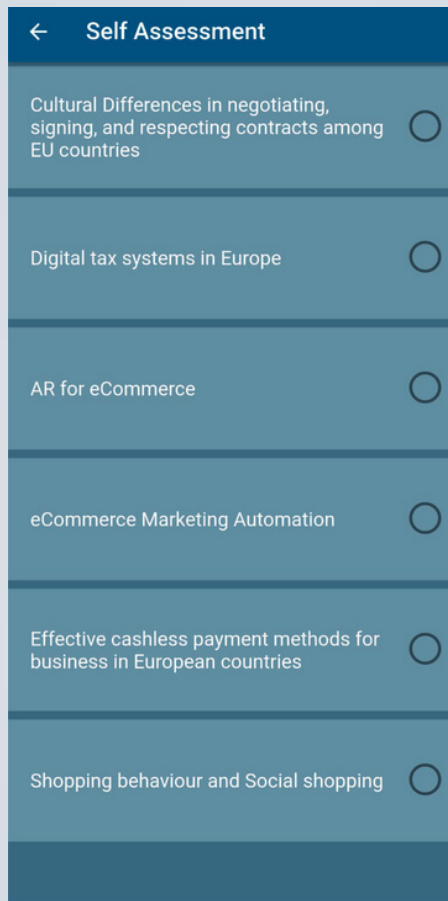
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DigiER mobile application for entrepreneurs
