3. Background and experience

KAINOTOMIA is a Vocational Education and Training Institution which was founded in 2013 by a group of people with an expertise and a lifelong commitment to the subject of learning.

The goal of the KAINOTOMIA is the implementation of continuous vocational training programs targeted at youth, unemployed people, educators of all education levels, students of higher education, employed/self-employed persons and vulnerable social groups (migrants, refugees, disabled people), for the development of professional opportunities and their promotion and integration into the labour market and the society in general. To strengthen our beneficiaries' capacities for their labour transition we provide Career Guidance and Counseling in close cooperation with regional stakeholder networks and according to individual needs.

KAINOTOMIA goal is the support of trainees aiming to improve their personal development and introduce new learning and teaching methodologies approaches, especially those delivering key competences and basic skills, language skills, and focusing on the use of ICT. In addition, its aims include the upscaling and evolvement of the quality of education in sectors such as professionalization and professional development of teachers, trainers. Finally, to facilitate trainees' improvement with new

forms of learning and providing education and training, notably strategic use of open and flexible learning, virtual mobility, open educational resources and better exploitation of the ICT potential.

KAINOTOMIA's aim is to reinforce trainees' improvement in foreign languages through mobility in collaboration with other EU member states and to bolster cooperation with other countries of the European Union. We also aim to increase mobility between countries, to promote international cooperation, mutual cultural enrichment and advertise volunteering as an expression of an intercultural dimension based on solidarity and equality.

KAINOTOMIA provide business consultancy to companies & supporting services and consulting support services to trainees to facilitate their (re) entrance into the labour market.

The company partners with training networks and organisations across Europe to raise awareness, bring together key stakeholders to share experiences and discuss policy and provide access to Greek expertise. We are working to expand our training courses for entrepreneurship in Europe, both face-to-face and online.

KAINOTOMIA plays a leading role in national and regional level and holds extensive experience and unique competencies in both methodology development and production of practical solutions matching specific vocational and professional development needs.

Recently, our organization has been participating in many national projects under the name of "Grant beneficiaries system with Training Vouchers", of the Ministry of Labour, Social Security and Social Solidarity. The projects were aiming into strengthening entrepreneurship skills of young beneficiaries in order for them to enter the labour market while outlining market needs and skills mismatching. The activities include Sensitizing of stakeholders, counseling, education & training, business plan and business startup support, creation of business incubators.

KAINOTOMIA is certified from the Aristotle Certification Training and Assessment of the Aristotle University of Thessaloniki and a member of Association of Thessalian Enterprises and Industries (STHEV). Therefore, we have a strong network of approximately 60 collaborating Associations and partners in Greece and Europe. We work closely with national Universities and collaborate with local, regional and national institutions developing studies about Active Labour Market Policies, entrepreneurship, skills upgrading in business, guidance, training and labour integration of unemployed.

Kainotomia has a great experience as a coordinating and partners organization as it coordinated more than 65 national projects (where more than 1.300 people have been trained) and participating as a partner in 15 large EU programmes (EYE, KA2 Youth, VET, Adult Education and KA3 Support for policy reform) and was a coordinator of a KA1 VET mobility project (Innovative VET Curricula Development and Career Guidance for Learners with Special Needs). Moreover, KAINOTOMIA has been involved as associated partner in other two Erasmus+ Projects (Erasmus+ Sports: Let's START, Erasmus+ KA3 Structured Dialogue: You(th) in the Center) and selected, prepared and supported young people for the participation in the mobility and local activities of the aforementioned projects. KAINOTOMIA has also participated in the "Summer Camp in the City" initiative of Municipality of Larissa awarded by the UNESCO Learning Cities Network, where trainers of KAINOTOMIA implemented 6 workshops in three different schools of Larissa and trained more than 150 students on the themes of Human Rights and Human Rights Education. Last but not least, KAINOTOMIA works closely with national Universities and has a strong network of collaborating Associations and partners in Greece and Europe especially in the field of youth, entrepreneurship, environment, culture and sustainability.

The company employs 5 permanent staff (monthly paid employees), works with 5 external partners (financial and technical issues, marketing) and collaborates with approximately 10 trainers per year. Thus, there are 5 project coordinators and 15 other paid staff, including part-time staff.

Kainotomia as a life-long learning center, has as main target group young people (18-35) especially low skilled youth such as NEETs and term unemployed people and works towards their social inclusion, economic, and educational development through the development of innovative tools and methodologies, entrepreneurial skills, and economic knowledge. Kainotomia brings this experience and expertise on reaching out, support and activate young people with fewer opportunities through specialized trainings and counselling for personal and professional development. Kainotomia currently participates in 11 large scale EU projects in Youth, VET, Adult Education and social policy reform sector under the Erasmus Plus Programme. Through this Kainotomia has gained a significant knowledge in various themes and in project management and implementation.

KAINOTOMIA has considering experience in the youth sector as a provider of training, new skills for personnel development. Furthermore, KAINOTOMIA participates this period in the national project under the name of "Grant beneficiaries system in youth with Training Vouchers", of the Ministry of Labour, Social Security and Social Solidarity.
