AT THE 2016 RIO DE JANEIRO OLYMPICS FOR THE FIRST TIME IN THE HISTORY OF THE GAMES, A TEAM OF REFUGEES PARTICIPATED, "THE REFUGEE OLYMPIC TEAM - R.O.T."

THE TEAM, MADE UP OF 10 ATHLETES CHOSEN BY THE INTERNATIONAL OLYMPIC COMMITTEE REPRESENTED THE APPROXIMATELY 60 MILLION REFUGEES IN THE WORLD.

THE ATHLETES, SWIMMERS, MIDDLE DISTANCE RUNNERS, MARATHON RUNNERS AND JUDOKAS WERE OF DIFFERENT NATIONALITIES: SYRIAN, SOUTH SUDANESE, ETHIOPIAN AND CONGOLESE AND THEY MARCHED, AT THE OPENING OF THE GAMES, UNDER THE FLAG OF THE OLYMPICS.
