Did you know? Sexual bullying is the second most frequent form of bullying in many regions, according to the Global School-Based Student Health Survey (GSHS). This lack of a safe learning environment for children is unacceptable.

Unfortunately, a lack of awareness and training for educators often leaves students, particularly girls and young women, vulnerable to harassment.
